3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction

- ► Changed the syllabus for M.A.(History) with the help of Curriculum Development Cell. The curriculum provides scope to expose the major shades of historiography and updating of it. In that case it includes the history of the marginalized sections through papers like Women through the Ages, Economic History, Dalit Movement, Contemporary India, History of USA, History of Europe, Dravidian movement, Environmental History of India and Global History (1600 1914).
- ➤ Curriculum for M.E. (CSE), M.Phil. M.C.A. is revised for the academic year 2012-2013. Job oriented Elective Subjects are introduced.
- ▶ A meeting of Board of Studies was held to revise the curriculum for M.Sc., (Statistics with Computer Applications) degree course. Revision of curriculum was made keeping in view of improving the employment opportunities to the students in India and abroad. In this respect calculator based practical papers were replaced with computer based practical papers. In addition a separate paper 'Data Analysis Using SAS' was introduced as core paper.
- ▶ A Meeting of Board of Studies was held to design curriculum for M.Sc., (Statistics and Information Technology), which is a new course launched under UGC Innovative Programme. Papers from the subjects of Statistics and Information Technology were introduced which made the course as an Inter disciplinary programme.
- ▶ In view of enriching the existing syllabus of M.Sc. Pharmaceutical Chemistry (CBCS) course, the Board of Studies was conducted in collaboration with Curriculum Development Cell (CDC) for two days on 10th and 11th May 2013 with the internal faculty members, Alumni including the foreign subject expert, Dr. Sivakumar Manickam, Professor of Chemical and Nano Pharmaceutical Process Engineering, The University of Nottingham Malaysia campus, Malaysia and the industrial expert, Dr. M. S. M. Mujeebur Rahuman, Director, Project Management API, Dr. Reddy's Laboratories Ltd., Hyderabad, in order to revise the syllabus for exposing and training the students to meet the present day of Industrial scenario.
- ▶ Peer tutoring is followed remedial coaching is given for the M.Ed

Students.

One can reach that place by half-an-hour because, there are old house and markets, temples and hectic traffic to reach the major hospitals and Government hospitals with adequate staffs and other infrastructures.

In the university there are more than 2000 persons including students, teaching faculties and Administrative staffs. Both Gent's hostel and Women's hostel are in this university campus. For any emergencies and other ailments we have to provide proper medical aid. Qualified persons are appointed in this hospital, as per the National Health Policy stated.

The facilities available in this Health center:

Sufficient furniture's are provided including patient cot, important surgical instruments etc. Other instruments like B.P apparatus, Glucometer, infrared lamps and oxygen cylinder are being used. Sufficient financial sanctions are made for purchasing medicines. Student with all type of diseases are properly treated for free of cost. Three cots are available and if necessary the patients are admitted and render suitable treatment.

Future expansion:

The construction of the patients ward was started and it will be completed within three months. We have already given one proposal for setting up Laboratory for blood analysis and other examinations. In this proposal we have requested one ECG Machine. After construction of inpatient ward one physiotherapy unit will be provided with qualified person. Other medical staffs are also requested to the University authorities.
